Horse Riding in Wild Wales – 2 Day Guided Tour

Our adventure into Wild Wales! The first stop is **Chepstow** with its impressive castle - the oldest stone fortress in the country. After lunch stop we explore the **Wye Valley** and visit the ruins at **Tintern**, a 12th century Cistercian Abbey. We continue our journey to the dramatic hill country of South Wales and visit **Hay-on-Wye**, the famous town of books. Our second day includes **horseback riding in the Brecon Beacons National Park**, taking in remote bridleways and ancient tracks with views of the stunning mountains, an important feature of the Welsh countryside. A relaxing stop in a village pub for food and refreshment (food and drink extra).

No knowledge of horse riding required! Experienced instructor accompany group. All horses are well trained and used to special trails.
